Background and Professional Experience:

In addition to working for FCA, Mr. White also holds the position of Truck Captain for a leading fire department in Southern California. He has been working in the fire service for 25 years, serving in many capacities. Recently he has served his city as an acting Battalion Chief and currently resides on a promotional list for that position. Captain White is responsible for complex high rise and commercial occupancy inspections. He has served as a member of the Hazardous Materials Team, functioned for 16 years as a Paramedic, 6 years as a Captain and 6 years as a Fire Arson Investigator. Captain White has participated in over 150 origin and cause investigations and acted as the lead investigator on over 60 fires. He has also testified as an expert witness in Superior Court for arson and attempted murder case.

Mr. White excels at teaching and is used often by his department in this capacity. He has developed a Wildland Urban Interface safety course, Rapid Intervention Crew tactics and also a Jr. Fire Firefighter program for the Newport Mesa School District. He has severed as guest lecturer at Saddleback College for Paramedic students and functioned as a Paramedic Preceptor. Captain White was chosen by his department to head a new program in the school district called Open Airways for Schools which was designed to help children with asthma. He also led the instruction in his department for the new Multi Casualty Incident Program as well as the CERT program.

Mr. White is a California State Fire Marshal Level II Arson Investigator and possesses the qualifications of a Chief Officer. He has a 16-hour accreditation in State RIC training and is a Strike Team Leader Trainee. Mr. White is a member of CCAI, IAAI and the Orange County Arson Task Force. He also serves as the Training Coordinator for the OC Arson Task Force.
