INTRODUCTION:

Thomas Kane specializes in fire cause investigation and consultation. Along with the position of Fire Investigator with Fire Cause Analysis, Mr. Kane is currently employed by the City of Scottsdale, Arizona Police Department and is the lead Arson Investigator for the Criminal Investigations Division. Mr. Kane has investigated and determined the cause and origin of over three hundred fires occurring in commercial structures, residential homes, recreational vehicles, automobiles, and wildlands. Mr. Kane also has been recognized as an expert witness in both criminal and civil court.
